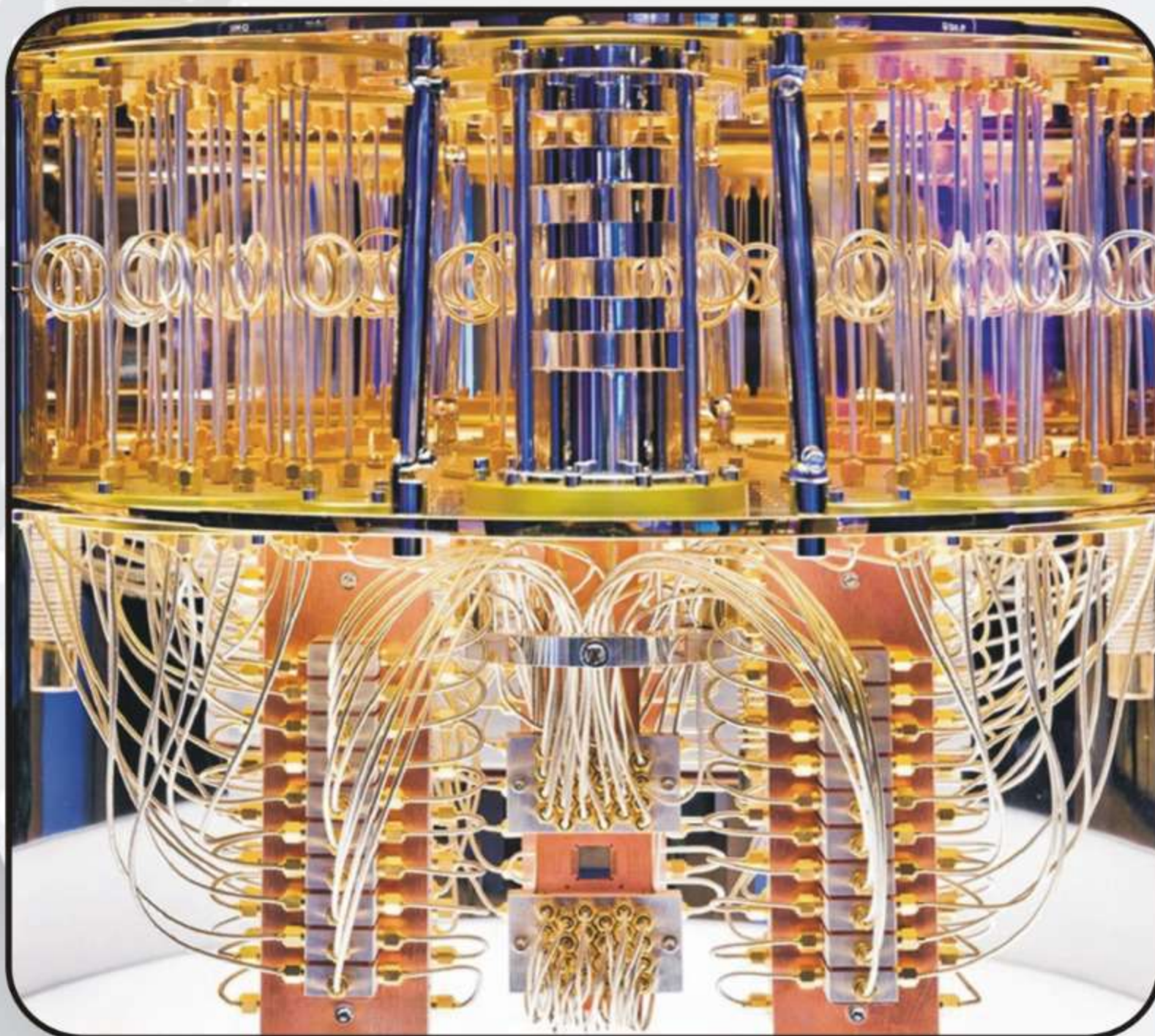

## India's Quantum Computer

India's quantum computer is the proposed and planned quantum computer to be developed in India by 2026. A quantum computer is a computer based on quantum phenomena and governed by the principles of quantum mechanics in physics. The development in the field of quantum computing in the world is also intricately linked to India. The legacy of quantum computing in India can be traced back from the period of Indian theoretical physicist Satyendra Nath Bose. His last four publication on quantum statistics and condensed matter physics led to the foundation of quantum mechanics. It was published in the year 1924.

The first quantum computer India launch was of 7 qubits developed at Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, Mumbai. In April 2025, An Indian startup named QpiAi unveiled a 25 qubit Quantum Computer named Indus, this quantum computer launched, is the first full-stack quantum computing system in the country selected under National Quantum Mission India (NQM), Government of India scheme. In the next five years, it is expected that India will invest around one billion dollars in the programs related to the development of the quantum computer. The Government of India has launched an initiative to development of the India's quantum computer.

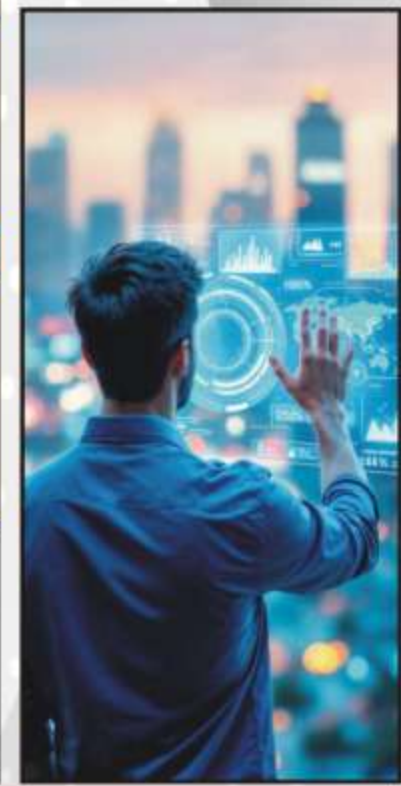

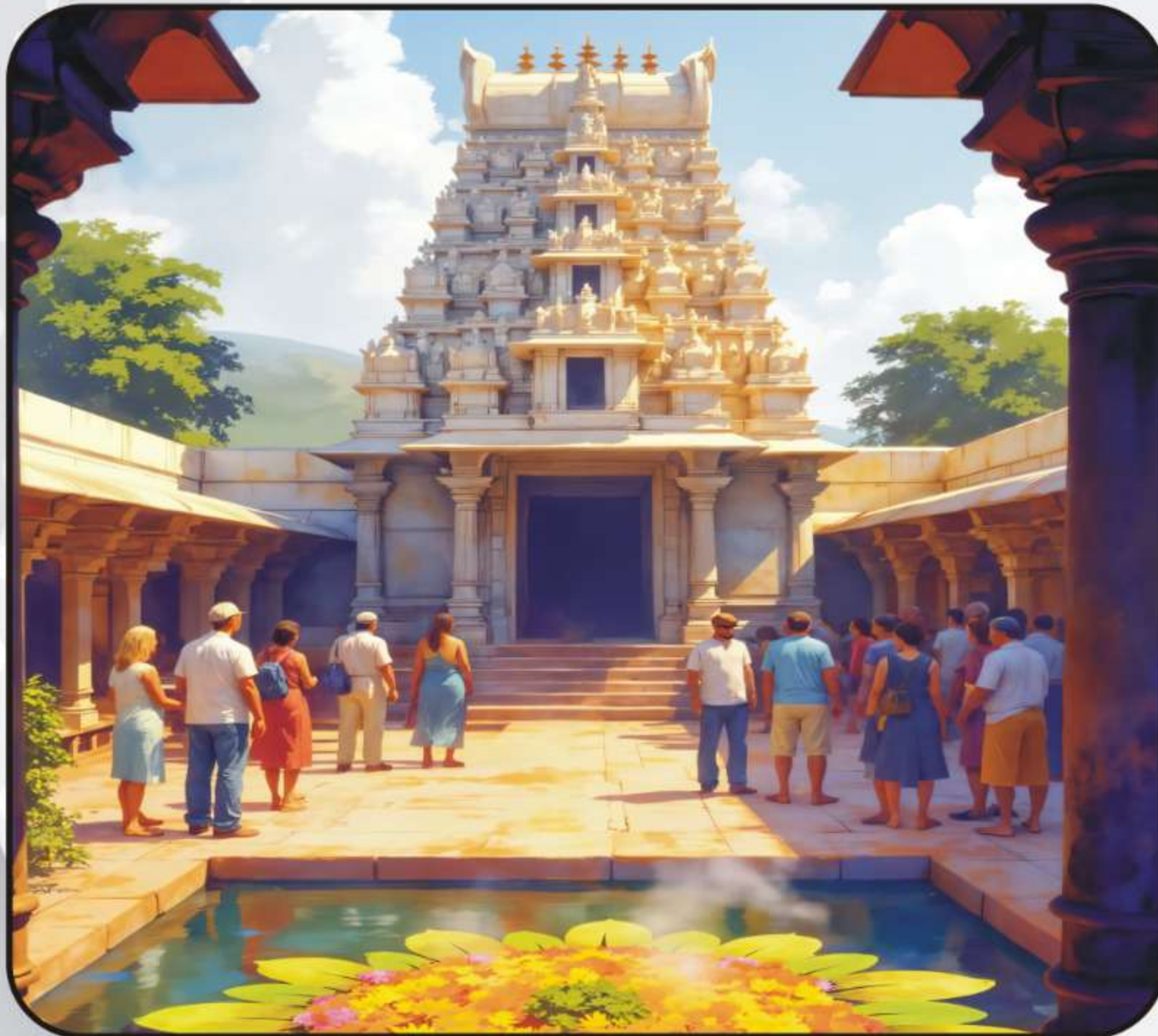

## India's First Missile - Rocket Launch

Thumba Equatorial Rocket Launching Station (TERLS) is India's first rocket launching station and was established on 21 November 1963. Operated by ISRO, it is located in Thumba, Thiruvananthapuram, which is near the south-western tip of mainland India, very close to Earth's magnetic equator. It is currently used by ISRO for launching sounding rockets.

The first rockets were assembled in the former Saint Louis High School, which now houses a space museum. The local Bishop of Trivandrum, Rev. Peter Bernard Periera, along with Vincent Victor Dereere (a Belgian) and district collector Madhavan Nair were instrumental in acquiring a large parcel of land measuring 600 acres from coastal community. Periera had given away the prayer hall and bishop's room in the local church. Minister of State for External Affairs, Lakshmi N. Menon helped to smooth bureaucratic hurdles facing the project in Delhi. H. G. S. Murthy was appointed as the first Director of Thumba Equatorial Rocket Launching Station.

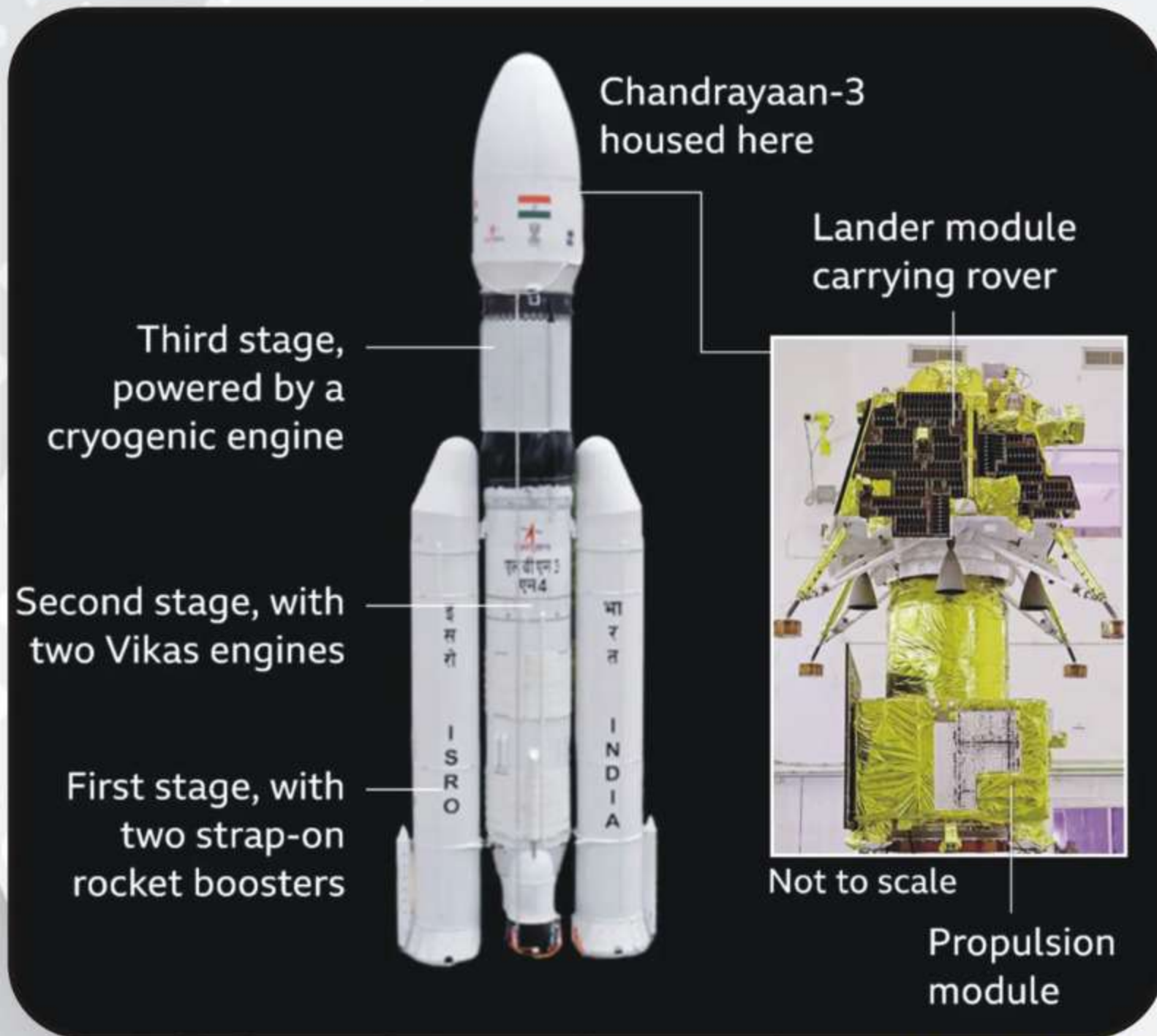

## Chandrayaan 3 Mission...

One of the many goals of the Mission is to look for water ice that could support future human life on the Moon and also for supplying propellants for spacecraft in future interplanetary missions.

With the successful landing of Chandrayaan-3 on August 23, India established itself as a major player in the global space economy. With only three nations having single-handedly succeeded in landing on the moon before, namely the United States, China, and Russia, this successful landing put India alongside them, lifting it from being a rising spacefaring nation and turning it into a global space power. On a similar landing time frame, Russia's Luna 25 was also expected to land near the lunar south pole, but it failed to land successfully, but India's Chandrayaan-3 did, making its landing even more notable. Due to this, Chandrayaan-3 has acquired historical significance and serves as a testament to India's growing space exploration capabilities.
